- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Vet Center Eligibility
- 5 Expansion Act?!.
- 6 SEC. 2. EXPANSION OF VET CENTER SERVICES.
- 7 Section 1712A of title 38, United States Code, is
- 8 amended—

1	(1) by striking "clauses (i) through (iv)" both

4	(2) by striking "in clause (v)" both places it ap-
5	pears and inserting "in clause (vii)";

9	(B) by inserting after clause (iii) the fol-
